Physician Selection

If you have an employee who is injured on the job, it is highly recommended to have the injured worker seek initial treatment from a health professional specializing in Occupational Medicine. These physicians are care-specific providers who understand work-related injuries and share our return to work philosophy and support transitional work program. A complete list of preferred providers in your area can be accessed through our website at www.chsmco.com and clicking on Physician Search.

Please note that your injured worker is afforded the right to seek initial treatment from a physician of their choice, regardless of BWC certification status. After the initial visit, the injured worker must chose a BWC-certified provider as the physician of record.

If an injured worker desires to change physician of record (POR). They must notify CompManagement Health Systems (CHS), your managed care organization (MCO) in writing with your request. The injured worker must complete a **C-23 Notice to Change Physician of Record** (POR) and send it to CHS for processing. The notification must include the name and address of your new physician; reason for the requested change and you must sign the document.

CHS may not dispute the injured workers selection of a new POR nor shall CHS deny any request to change to a non-BWC certified provider. However, if a change is made to a non-BWC certified provider, CHS must clearly communicate to the injured worker at the time of the request that he/she will be responsible for medical payments and will have no recourse against the MCO, BWC or you, the employer.

An injured worker may only have one POR at any given time. In claims where more than one physician treats the injured worker, there still can only be one recognized POR.
